The Dog Control Orders (Prescribed Offences and Penalties, etc.) Regulations
2006 (S.I.2006/)

Tingewick Parish Council hereby gives NOTICE that it a DOG CONTROL ORDER was made on the 3rd March 2011 in respect of the whole of the land situated at Water Stratford Road, Tingewick (Tingewick Recreation Field) registered at HM Land Registry under title number BM196061. The Order will come into force on the 1st April 2011.

Under that Order it is an offence to: Take a dog onto, or permit a dog to enter or to remain on Tingewick Recreation Field without reasonable excuse or permission.

Nothing in this article applies to a person who—

(a) is registered as a blind person in a register compiled under section 29 of the National Assistance Act 1948; or

(b) is deaf, in respect of a dog trained by Hearing Dogs for Deaf People (registered charity number 293358) and upon which he relies for assistance; or

(c) has a disability which affects his mobility, manual dexterity, physical co-ordination or ability to lift, carry or otherwise move everyday objects, in respect of a dog trained by a prescribed charity

Penalty: A person who is in breach of this order shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

Map: A map of the area to be covered by the proposed order may be inspected free of charge at Honeysuckle Cottage, Water Stratford, Buckingham, MK18 5DS.
