Open Forum

Parking at Stowe View

The Chairman explained the outcome of two meetings that had taken place at Stowe View to consider the parking issue upon the demolition of the garages. Present were residents of Stowe View, Cllr Fealey - District Councillor, AVDC, the Parish Council, the Vale of Aylesbury Trust, and David Parker architects. Further written proposals were received as a result of the meetings which will be sent to all residents of Stowe View

Information has subsequently been received that eight garages the block of at the bottom of Stowe View, once refurbished, will be made available for residents use. There may also be provision to allow drives to be constructed for both tenants and private residents although funding can not be provided to private residents.

It was felt that progress was being made in that additional parking is being facilitated, further disabled spaces are being added and the prohibition on parking in front of the garages is being removed.

Concern was however raised that the refurbished garages may not be large enough to park an average size family car and negate the provision of such garages. This comment will be passed to the Vale of Aylesbury Housing Trust A revised planning application containing the amendments is awaited.

Provision of External Wi-Fi Access Points

The Local Area Forum has offered subsided external wi-fi access points with a range of 200 meters at a cost of £180 per village. It was felt that the practicalities of maintaining such a service would be disproportionate to the benefit of such a service given that there is a wide availability of wi-Fi.

The picnic table in the school playground is splintered and dangerous. It was confirmed that this is the responsibility of the school as it is their property. The rope ladder in the Recreation Field requires replacement.

Roads, Footways and Street Furniture

A written report received. Category one pot holes have been repaired, fly tipping has been reported and lighting that is not the responsibility of the Parish Council has been repaired.

Planning

The Vale of Aylesbury Planning Strategy has been received. Cllr Roy explained the key proposals.

AVDC is holding a seminar for Parish Councillors in respect of planning applications and how to raise comments.

AVDC has issued an information leaflet recommending local developers to consult with their local parish council prior to planning applications being submitted. Should such approaches be made this Parish Council takes the view that 'no objection' does not indicate the support of the Parish Council which will take a view of neutrality unless it opposes an application or believes a proposal will benefit the community as a whole.
