21	<p>Declarations of Interest The Chairman, Vice Chairman, Cllr Maxwell and Cllr Roy declared an interest in Item 31 - Recreation Ground Development - in that they are members of the Recreation Ground Working Party. Dispensation in accordance with section 33 of the Localism Act 2011 was sought by the Councillors from the Clerk and were granted as without this dispensation the number of persons prohibited from participating in the decision regarding the development of the Recreation Field would be so great a proportion of the Council as to impede the transaction of the business.</p>

23	<p>Matters Arising for information and reports only Item 12 - Cemetery - The sinking grave has been filled and turfed Item 12 - Playground -The replacement parts for the climbing wall has been ordered. Item 15 Correspondence - The South Central Ambulance Service will be invited to discuss and demonstrate the Public Access Defibrillator Scheme at 8.00pm before the next Parish Council meeting on the 4th July. 24	<p>County Councillor's Report Cllr Stutchbury has had discussions with Aylesbury Vale Housing Trust regarding the provision of off road parking at Stowe View. Discussions have also been held with TfB regarding highway priorities to see if they can more appropriately reflect the needs in the local area. The County Council's highways budget has been increased. The County Council is restructuring its staffing to produce a more cost effective service.</p>

25	<p>District Councillor's Report</p> <p>Apologies received. Cllr Fealey confirmed via the Chairman that he is still actively engaged in the issue regarding Stowe View.</p>
	<p><i>Open Forum</i> There is some concern that residents may be asked to contribute financially to enable parking on the 'amenity land'. Further information is required. There was also some concern at the loss of flexible parking in the area. The Parish Council has objected to the current application and indicated that it wishes to be heard at Committee Level. The Parish Council had understood that a substantially revised application would be submitted but none has yet been received for consideration. Clarification will be sought as to when the revisions to the planning application will be made available. Action: Clerk When the matter goes to Committee residents are able to make comments.</p> <p><u>Wayside, Main Street</u> An update was received regarding the development of the property by the auction house.</p> <p><u>Historical Society</u> The Historical Society intends to research the names on the War Memorial to commemorate the centenary of World War One. Grant funding may be available. The matter will be placed on the agenda for the next meeting to consider whether the village may wish to consider commemorating the event and if so in what way.</p>
