This may sound a little premature, BUT... it's not, those bulbs need time to come to their best, get planting !!!!

#### **GOLDEN TRUMPET - SINGLE FLOWERED DAFFODIL**

- Class 1 1 Bulb grown in a pot max size 2 litres
- Class 2 3 Bulbs grown in a pot max size 5 litres
- Class 3 5 Bulbs grown in a pot max size 7.5 litres

#### **SINGLE FLOWERED DAFFODIL ANY COLOUR ANY KIND**

- Class 4 Any number of bulbs in a pot maximum size 12 inches in diameter

#### **GOLDEN DUCAT - DOUBLE FLOWERED DAFFODIL**

- Class 5 1 Bulb grown in a pot max size 2 litres
- Class 6 3 Bulbs grown in a pot max size 5 litres
- Class 7 5 Bulbs grown in a pot max size 7.5 litres

#### **DOUBLE FLOWERED DAFFODIL ANY COLOUR ANY KIND**

- Class 8 Any number of bulbs in a pot maximum size 12 inches in diameter

#### **MINNOW -MINIATURE DAFFODIL**

- Class 9 Minnow bulbs in a bowl or pot maximum size 9 inches diameter 8 bulbs per pot recommended

#### **MINIATURE/DWARF DAFFODILS ANY KIND (Tete a Tete is a recommended kind)**

- Class 10 Any number of bulbs in a bowl or pot maximum size 9 inches diameter

#### **TULIP – PINOCCHIO**

- Class 11 Pinocchio bulbs in a bowl or pot maximum size 9 inches diameter 7 bulbs per pot recommended

#### **DWARF/MINIATURE TULIPS ANY KIND MAX HEIGHT 9 INCHES**

- Class 12 Any number of bulbs in a bowl or pot maximum size 9 inches diameter

#### **HYACINTH – BLUE JACKET**

- Class 13 1 bulb grown in a pot max size 2 litres or bowl max size 9 inches dia.

#### **HYACINTH ANY COLOUR ANY KIND**

- Class 14 3 bulbs grown in a pot max size 5 litres or bowl max size 9 inches dia.
