
Tingewick Circular Walk

Bernwood Jubilee Way



- 1. The walk begins by the stile of a grassland field to the northeast of the village
- 2. Parish Church of St Mary Magdalene dates to late C12
- 3. The Old School dated 1828
- 4. At the end of the thatched roofed cottages turn left into Wood Lane
- 5. The lane opens to an area of damp grassland
- 6. The path now turns right along the edge of Tingewick Wood
- 7. The path bears left into the woodland
- **8.** Vista of Tingewick Meadows Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI)
- Use existing bridge near the road to proceed further
- **10.** Proceed through the dell surrounded by trees
- 11. Cross the stream at the footbridge at the end of the fenced fishing lake
- 12. The path exits the field to arrive at a road turn right
- **13.** Continue along left side of the road towards junction
- **14.** The circular walk is complete at the bridge over the bypass
