WHAT IS ASK FOR ANGELA?

Ask for Angela is an initiative to raise awareness of sexual violence and abuse.

The aim is to stop harassment that some people experience in social situations by enabling people who are feeling unsafe or threatened while on a date to alert bar staff so they can then defuse the situation or arrange a safe way of getting home.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Every pub or bar that supports the initiative will have visible posters located in the toilets or a sticker displayed on the window at the premises entrance.

If you feel unsure, fearful or uneasy ask a member of staff for 'ANGELA' and the staff will make sure that you are safe.
